Duane indicated that your help is needed if the Iowa Lions Foundation is to meet its budget for this year. He encouraged all the clubs in Iowa to help fund the entities supported by the Foundation by making a donation. He also encouraged individual Lions to make personal donations to

the Foundation. Everyone making a personal donation of \$20 or more will receive the cardinal and gold 2008-2009 "I Gave" pin. Club and personal donations can be sent to your district trustee or the state office. Each district is being asked to raise \$30,000 through various methods including sale of "I Gave" pins, donations, special basketball shot promotion, raffle tickets, golf outings, etc. The goal is to raise \$281,000 to help fund the seven programs that the Lions Club of Iowa Foundation supports. The programs include: Iowa KidSight, Iowa Lions Eye Bank, Iowa Lions Hearing Aid Bank, Leader Dog/Puppy Program, Education for Blind Children, Iowa School for the Deaf and University of Iowa Cochlear Implant Center.
